### WHY HARMONIZE THE GOSPELS?

In clear, powerful language the Gospel writers present Jesus Christ—who He is, what He said, what He did, the meaning of His life. Although the four authors tell the same story, each has a particular focus and purpose in writing. Reading a harmony of the Gospels brings the work of each writer into a single narrative, like a story told by four people, each contributing some things unique and some things the same. Matthew wrote to fellow Jews who were acquainted with the Old Testament prophecies concerning a coming Messiah. Mark emphasized the action, drama and impact of Christ's ministry. Luke gathered material from eyewitnesses to give a historical picture of Jesus. John reflected on Christ's purpose for coming to the earth. He set his Gospel in the framework of the annual holy days.

## FEBRUARY 2016

After finishing the harmony of the Gospels, we will read the remainder of the New Testament and the Old Testament in what some scholars believe was the original order. According to C.R. Gregory, the New Testament order is the Gospels; Acts; the general letters of James, Peter, John and Jude; Paul's letters; and, finally, the book of Revelation (*Canon and Text of the New Testament*, pp. 467-469). This is also the order used by Ivan Panin in his translation, *The New Testament*. Since to the Jews were "committed the oracles of God" (Romans 3:2), we will follow their traditional order of the Old Testament. This order of the Law, the Prophets and the Writings was confirmed by Christ (Luke 24:44). As you read the Scriptures in this order, what insights do you find over the order found in most Bibles today?
